Council approved spending up to \$500.00 for Operation Santa. Approval was also given to spend \$200.00 towards Wakulla Senior Citizen's Thanksgiving activities, if needed.

The Council opted to discontinue advertising the park and gym in the Wakulla Neighbor publication.

A motion was made to approve the financial reports for October. Rudd/Lewis, passed 5/0.

Commissioner Edwards informed the other members of the Council that she met with volunteers to get natural landscaping options and ideas for the Depot Park.

With the current City Clerk, Jackie Lawhon, retiring May 31, 2016, Commissioner Lewis inquired as to the job vacancy announcement coming out in December. The Council needs to have their plan in place at the December meeting as to the length of time for advertisement, interview board, time frame requiring hiree to relocate, etc.
